

HIGH POINT COMMUNITY EMERGENCY SIREN WARNING GUIDE



TORNADO WARNING

In the event of a “Tornado” emergency, as issued by NOAA:

Emergency Siren will sound for one minute, then off for thirty seconds, then repeat the above cycle until the tornado emergency is clear, then the ***Emergency Siren*** will sound for a short blast to give the ALL CLEAR.

MANDATORY EVACUATION

In the event of a “Mandatory Evacuation” of High Point, as issued by the Hernando County Emergency Management:

Emergency Siren will sound for three minutes, then off for one minute, then repeat the above cycle for a duration of fifteen minutes. The ***Emergency Siren*** will then rest for five minutes, then repeat the above cycle for a mandatory evacuation.

Our High Point Mobile Patrol will be going through the community announcing the mandatory evacuation and shelter location.
