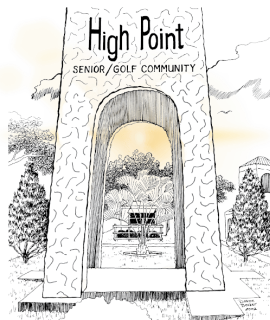

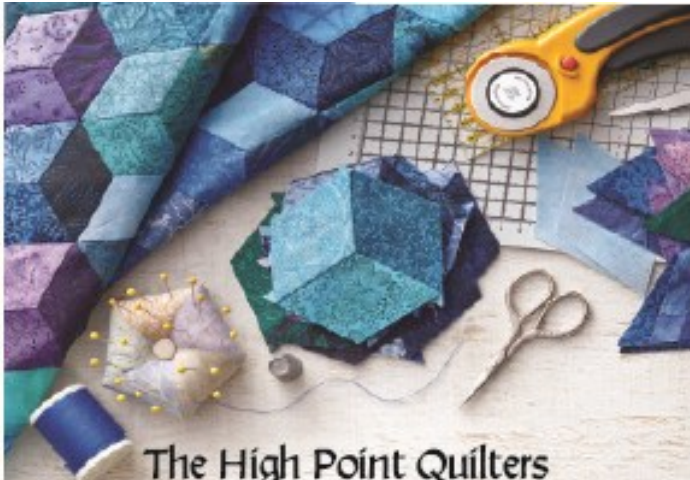
Come visit our monthly meeting on the second Thursday of the month at 7PM. Everyone is invited to come learn what Lions are all about.

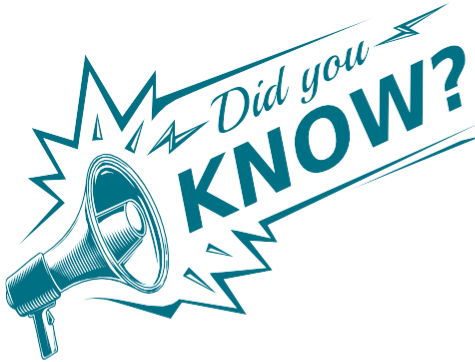

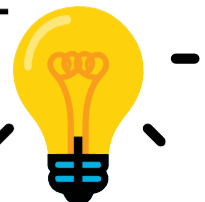

Landscaping Tips - June 2026

“Summer Annuals, Vegetables, Hernando County Fertilizer Restrictions, Hurricane Season, Free Gardening Classes and Activities, and High Point Beauty Spot of the Month”

“Where but in a garden do summer hours pass so quickly?” – Anon

According to the University of Florida Service Extension, **Annuals** that can tolerate full sun during the summer months include **Vinca, Celosia, and Coleus**. Go to: *Annuals*:

Vegetables to plant now include Okra, Southern Pea, Calabaza, Malabar spinach, and sweet potato. Go to: *Vegetable Gardening in Florida*:

The Hernando County Fertilizer Ordinance, starting June 1st through September 30th, **prohibits** the use of urban turf fertilizers containing nitrogen (N). **Ref: Hernando County Ordinance – Sec.28-505 to 28-519**

Hurricane season normally runs June 1st through Nov. 30th with the most activity between mid-Aug. to mid-October. **Colorado State Univ. experts are predicting lower than normal activity with 13 Named storms, six being hurricanes, and two category three or above. This is due to a moderate to strong El Niño driving increase levels of Atlantic wind shear.** Check your trees for bad branches and prune as needed. Be prepared! See: *Pruning Landscape Trees and shrubs*. http://edis.ifas.ufl.edu/topic_tree_pruning
